



This documentation is crucial in promptly identifying and addressing student needs. This report offers valuable insights into the effectiveness of our academic advising across departments.

My advisees generally expect me to be accessible through Microsoft Teams and prefer face-to-face meetings rather than relying solely on ATS notes and emails. At the start of each semester, I download the list of advisees from the ATS system, which provides their cumulative GPA, allowing me to understand the overall and current academic situations of each student.

As an academic advisor, my role extends beyond merely helping students with course registration. I focus on guiding them to select appropriate courses that balance their academic load. However, I have faced challenges when selecting courses for evening students due to limited course availability, conflicts, and prerequisite requirements. As a result, their study plans are given special attention to track their progress from the first year onwards.

Typically, in the first and second years, I ensure that course registration aligns with both faculty and department requirements. For third-year students, it's crucial to strike a balance between department requirements and supporting courses. This approach has been instrumental in improving students' cumulative GPAs. It has not only helped students overcome the 'at-risk' status but also led to a significant overall GPA improvement."

My responsibilities as an academic advisor begin a few weeks before classes commence. During this time, I ensure that all necessary forms are prepared in advance of the course registration period. Generally, students are encouraged to register online, with technical support available for those encountering any issues.

The previous semester's GPA plays a pivotal role at this stage as it determines the students' eligibility for registration in the upcoming semester. I have implemented various strategies, such as reaching out to at-risk students via email, requesting urgent appointments with advisees. 



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
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
