Al Hinai received a tag "mentioned "on her painting which indicates preferred artwork by the panel of judges. The young artist believes that "Your goals have no expiration date".


Computer Science Dept. Thrives at the 9th Oman Collegiate Programming Contest

Reflection

Rethinking the use of UKPSF from the HEI Point of View

The purpose of this article is to place the phenomenon of United Kingdom professional standard framework (UKPSF) in proper perspective as an expedient response to the call for the .use of UKPSF in HEI's in different climes

UKPSF is an all embracing and encompassing set of professional standards and guidelines framework used by pedagogists, who play a dominant role in teaching and supporting learning in HEI cutting across diverse parts of the world

UKPSF has remained firmly anchored and resolute on its underpinning role in shaping academic development and the professional recognition of higher educationist at national and international level

Its influence over teaching and supporting learning in higher education through the global market economy is likely to grow in importance by virtue of the confidence placed on its authority and ability for maintaining trust in the teaching and learning strategy framework.

Predominantly, it has become mandatory for academic staff, in the vast majority of institutions to undertake programs, which have a bearing with the UKPSF descriptor such as the Post Graduate Certificate in the International Higher Education Academic Practice (PG CERT) on entry to a teaching or learning support role. Most of these programs are accredited by the Higher Education Academy against the UK Professional Standards for Teaching.

Quite paradoxically, institutions were declining and being blighted at a time, due to wider political context and particular to the implications of the white paper on student's enrolment, potential changing nature of students and fees

Conclusively, delegates in the academia, were of the utmost opinion that, it bestowed on them to be able to position themselves to react to changes in institutional identity and the resultant effect on the relationship between Research and Teaching in their institution

Reflection

Mapping Teaching -Learning to the UK Professional Standard Framework for Continuously Improving Teaching and Learning Quality.

Oman College of Management and Technology (OCMT) has a long-term access partnership with Advance HE that includes the Higher Education Academy (HEA). Although, the institutional fellowship of the HEA was obtained in the academic year 2022-2021, the adoption of the publicly published UKPSF standards for teaching and learning evaluation analysis was prior to its institutional membership acquisition.

Teaching and learning and supporting teaching and learning is the primary mission of the College, which is explicitly stated on its mission statement. Its partnership is remarkable evidence of the College continuing commitment to amplify professional development of teaching staff on providing invigorating learning experience for its students.

OCMT adoption of UKSPF as one of its external references and guiding frameworks is prevalent across its academic practices. For instance, the three pillars of UKSPF indicators were used to review the previous and aligned its revised version of Peer Observation Form that support and underpin student learning.

UK Professional Standard Framework is also reflected in Teaching Evaluation Survey of the College, which conducted to the student's semester -wise, and considered to be unique assessment tool in the region.

In view of the College 's Continuous Professional Development Programme (CPDP), the Quality Assurance Department ensures and verifies registrations of Academic Staff members in both HE Advance and HE Connect. Both academic and administrative staff members are required to attend five (5) webinars / workshop on monthly basis with the freedom to choose topics and time of their need and preference based on the collected feedback from the Training Need Analysis (TNA) survey at the beginning of the academic year.

Underpinning these essential academic practices have maximizes the benefits of scholarly activities to a reflective pedagogic understanding and subsequent development of teaching and learning.

Truly, OCMT's partnership with the Advance HE has demonstrated a high-quality impact to the Institution's commitment to quality education by providing its learners with exemplary learning experiences, and cultivating the culture of reflective teaching and learning among its enthusiastic staff members to create a strong foundation for sharing their disciplinary knowledge and skills based on effective pedagogic.

Reflection

Rethinking the use of UKPSF from the HEI Point of View

Oman College of Management and Technology (OCMT) is a higher education institution in Oman whose mission is providing the society with knowledgeable, skillful and critically thinking graduates who are ready to face the challenges of the modern world. On its journey to quality assurance and meeting the standards set by the Oman Authority for Academic Accreditation and Quality Assurance of Education, last academic year the college has become a member of Advance HE and opted for a long-term commitment (membership) of 3 years.

Prior to acquiring membership, the college adopted publicly published UK Professional Standards Framework (UKPSF) for analysis purposes. As a result, some changes have been implemented and have become a sound foundation of the Teaching Evaluation Policy. Let's take a closer look at some of them.

Firstly, the college Peer Observation Form was modified. The updated version is fully mapped with the three pillars of the UKPSF. This change allowed both the observer and the instructor who is being observed to look at the lesson in different dimensions. Based on the peer observation report received by me last semester, I was able to take a closer look at the Area of Activity with regards to assessment and providing feedback to learners.

Another change that took place was related to the Teaching Evaluation Survey which is filled out by the students at the end of each semester for each course they've taken. This practice existed in the college prior to the adoption of UKPSF. However, mapping the survey with the Framework allowed the college to conduct deeper analysis into such important areas as professional development for the staff and improvement of the teaching quality at the institution. When we look at the consolidated data of the Teaching Evaluation Surveys, we can see significant positive changes that took place over the past few uears.

One more step towards embedding UKPSF in the college's practice was the introduction of ways to engage in continuing professional development via Advance HE platforms. Last academic year, based on Training Needs Analysis the Quality Assurance Department created a Flexible Professional Development Plan listing various reading materials, webinars, and events. The college staff were then encouraged to access the above-mentioned resources and reflect on how the received knowledge could be used in their teaching.

Looking back, the acquired data suggests that the UKPSF was successfully adopted within the teaching quality evaluation. Looking forward, OCMT plans to sponsor its faculty members to apply for HEA Fellowship.

Interview Excerpt:

How does it feel that your research was granted by The Research Council?

The research grant from MoHERI is really an encouragement for us, and we feel that it is an inspiration to all researchers in OCMT. It was a happy moment and out of 465 research projects submitted for block funding program in 120,2022 projects are selected, and our project was one among them.

Would you give us a brief background to your research?

The goal of this research project is to develop a framework to track the process of e-waste collection and management. The main technical components of the proposed e-waste management framework are a smart bin to collect e-waste, an IoT-deep learning-based model for e-waste classification, a cloud server to store and process the data, and an end-user application.

Why did you think of this research project? How do you see this work impacting the community at large?

Electronic waste (e-waste) management is a serious concern for every nation as its volume is drastically increasing. Asian countries contribute to the highest quantity of global e-waste in 2019 at 24.9 million metric tons. Currently, Oman does not have streamlined process for e-waste collection, classification, and management. From an economic perspective, e-waste management provides a significant opportunity for a circular economy as it contains different metals, and they are the source of secondary raw materials. The proposed e-waste management framework will help Oman to achieve the sustainable development goals for a greener and low carbon environment.

What are the limitations of your study?

The current research mainly focuses on classifying limited e-waste items.

What's the status of your research study at the moment?

Currently, we are conducting a literature review on the applicability of various 4th industrial revolution technologies for E-waste management.

What motivated you to submit your research project to The Research Council?

The research grant is an opportunity for academia to contribute towards society in solving real problems. In academia, research is an integral part of our work and the MoHERI is providing different platforms to support the research community, and block funding program is one such initiative.

How was the submission process to TRC like?

The submission process was completely online, a faculty can submit the application through RIMS systems and other stakeholders involved in the submission process are Research Focal Point and the Institutional Internal Evaluation Committee.

What would be your message / piece of advice to researchers like you who also aspire that their research project will be granted by TRC?

It is always better to align the research problem with national research priorities of Oman and especially with Oman vision 2040.

What is next after this research project?

We will continue our academic research to secure research grants and give more focus on national research priorities.

One of the Best Five Research Awardees at **Oman Conference on Environmental Sustainability**

Interview Excerpt:

Would you please enlighten us, what is Oman Conference on Would you give us a brief background to your research? Environmental Sustainability all about?

It is the first edition of 'Oman Conference on Environmental Sustainability, which is attended by 'HH Sayyid Theyazin bin Haitham al Said, Minister of Culture, Sports, and Youth, presided over the inaugural ceremony of the starting day on January 16. The four-day conference focuses on air pollution and climate change. The conference also includes the launch of the "Green Dough Award" for contributors and supporters of environmental work from institutions and individuals to encourage their outstanding and distinguished contributions in various environmental fields. It was organized in collaboration with Sultan Qaboos University and Oman society of Environment. The conference seeks to promote research, development, and innovation by choosing the best 5 research papers.

What motivated you to submit/ present your research paper project?

I decided to submit my paper to this conference hopping to have a platform which help me to make my ambition come true in changing my research recommendation into actions because the building sector alone accounts for %38 of global energy related carbon dioxide emissions according to UNEP report of 2020, thus countries need to set plans to achieve a measurable impact in mitigating climate change and of course this will not happen without effective researches in addition to political decisions, and these kind of conferences act as a platform that researchers can pass their ideas and recommendation.

How does it feel to be chosen as one of best research papers during the National Conference?

This is by the grace of Allah. It was a surprise because the organizer didn't announce that. I just received a call saying it is important to attend the conference's closing ceremony. I went there sat extremely far at the back, so organizer approached me and told me to come at the front because my paper was selected by the scientific committee of the conference as one of the best 5 researches. I was incredibly happy, and I felt grateful and pleased.

I studied Energy consumption in buildings which is one of the main sources of greenhouse gas emissions. I found that decarbonizing the energy demand of buildings involves two approaches: first, reductions in energy demand, and second, a reduction in the carbon content of energy by shifting to clean renewable energy sources. I started my research by reviewing the effort done by different countries toward achieving SDGs, I found that some countries that account for a large share of global CO2 emissions have started energy efficiency initiatives. Nevertheless, same effort is not performed by Arab countries. Of the 163 member countries of UN, listed in the 2022 Sustainable Development Report, only four countries score more than 69 points (Algeria, Tunisia, Jordan, and Oman). The objective is to present numerical forecasts of demand after renovation. Extensive measurements have been conducted and used as input data for the building energy simulation program. The proposed renovation project has resulted in a %38 reduction in energy consumption, in addition to %41 of the total energy consumption met by solar energy.

Why did you think of this research project? How do you see this work impacting the community at large?

I started this research in 2020 when UN Environment Emissions Gap Report (2020) stated that to limit global warming by 2 °C by 2050, carbon dioxide emissions in buildings would need to be reduced by %77, bringing the world closer to the Paris Agreement goals. As an architect and a designer specialized in Architecture in the field of energy efficient buildings and building energy performance simulation models, I decided to start to do research to help governments to take real measures toward achieving SDG goals.
