The Power of Language

Humans are distinguished from other animal species in our ability to translate and decode our thoughts and feelings into symbols and language. This is possible because our brains are wired and programmed differently.

Through language, humans were able to reserve history and early language symbols. Because of that, they were able to learn from past events.

Words not only carry meaning and thought, but also evoke emotions and feelings such as the attitude of the speaker. Humans can use words to encourage such as "well done", "good job", "I'm proud of you", or on the contrary, use words of despair or anger to discourage or humiliate like, "You're stupid!". Words can also heal or help. Words such as "I love you", "you're beautiful" can increase happy hormones in our bodies which can have healthy and healing properties.

Some words or concepts cannot be easily translated literally from one language to another, which is a common mistake the students make when trying to translate every single word from Arabic to English or any other language. That is why some words will not have an equivalent word in another language. These are called "Untranslatable words". Even though English may have over 750,000 words, it still doesn't offer the best words for every concept or feeling for words from other languages.













